If you wish to save any remaining components of mailbox supports or address signs, please collect them from the boulevard area near the street. Any remaining components near the street will be removed and disposed of next week.

[Shouldering Work & Temporary Signage:](#)

Following placement of the final layer of street pavement, additional topsoil along roadway shoulders is planned to be installed in Spring 2025. Signage indicating "Low Shoulder" will be placed throughout the project area until the remaining topsoil work has been completed.

[Water Ponding in Ditches:](#)

Water accumulation in ditch bottoms is a normal condition following rain events, especially in areas of newly placed sod or seed. As turf restoration continues and roots extend into the soil, the duration of ponding in ditch bottoms will begin to decrease. We appreciate your patience and understanding while root development takes place.
