This Week's Work

- Landwehr Construction continued installing new sanitary sewer and storm sewer mains in 3rd Avenue SW and in 2nd Street SW.
- Landwehr replaced water valves on 2nd Street SW at 2nd Avenue SW. Thank you for your patience to those who had water shut-off during that work.
- CenterPoint Energy's contractor, Michels, continues to replace the old steel gas main with new plastic main east of Central Avenue.

Next Week's Anticipated Work

- Landwehr will continue installing new sewer and water mains in 2nd Street SW towards Central Avenue.
- Water main replacement in 2nd Street SW may require more short term water service shut-offs. Residents/businesses along 2nd Street should watch for notices concerning water shut-offs.
- Michels will continue working towards the east on 2nd Street SE, east of Central Avenue, with gas main and service line replacement. Residents/businesses on 2nd Street may be contacted by CenterPoint as part of service replacement.

Street's Closed to Traffic

- 3rd Avenue SW between TH 23 and 2nd Street SW
- 2nd Street SW between 3rd Avenue SW and Central Avenue

Access Closures

- First National Bank drive through access will be closed intermittently over the next two weeks. Watch for signs.
