Project Schedule

- The City of Sandstone's contractor, A1 Excavating, began Phase 1 of the project, working on the following streets:
- Minnesota Street (between Grant and Pine Avenues)
- Washington Street (between the nursing home and Pine Ave)
- Division Street (between Pine Ave and Palisade Avenue)
- The contractor started by pulverizing the existing street pavement into the underlying gravel. This left a drivable surface similar to a gravel road and the streets will remain open to local traffic.
- We understand construction will be an inconvenience – we appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's streets!

Next Week's Anticipated Work

- A1 will pulverize the remaining project streets (6th Street, 5th Street, Court Ave. and Pine Avenue) on Tuesday (8/4) and Wednesday (8/5).
- A1 will be re-grading Division Street and 1st Street with curb removal in some areas.
- Access to your driveway on a project street should be open most of the time with the exception of when they are working directly in front of your house.
- If you have special access issues ie – medical deliveries, meal delivery, etc. please let Steve Rose know to help accommodate those - 612.759.1544.

Street's Closed to thru Traffic -

- Currently all streets will remain open to traffic, with short delays for construction activities.
- Even with streets open, PLEASE avoid a street currently under construction if possible
