Project Schedule

- New sanitary sewer and storm sewer mains have been installed on Pine Avenue.
- Grading crew prepped streets and installed new gravel base on 6th Street from Court thru Park Avenues
- Grading crew also prepped the intersections on 5th Street at Court and Park Avenues for new storm sewer work planned for next week.
- We understand construction will be an inconvenience – we appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's streets!

Next Week's Anticipated Work

- Curb will be completed on 1st Street after the gas company relocates the gas main,
- Curb will also be placed on Court Avenue and 6th Street
- Driveway aprons will be completed after new curb placement on 1st, Court and 6th as noted above. You will need to be out of your driveway for approximately 10 days while the concrete apron cures. During this time, you will be able to park in the street in front of your house.
- If you have special access issues ie – medical deliveries, meal delivery, etc. please let Steve Rose know to help accommodate those - 612.759.1544.

Street's Closed to thru Traffic -

- Pine Avenue between Washington Street and TH 123 will be closed the next 2 weeks to through traffic
- The remaining project streets should remain open. Even with streets open, PLEASE avoid a street currently under construction if possible
